

Q1. Several of the line items are per occurrence or application (bed edging, and pre-emergent and nonselective herbicide applications). Others (line trimming) are a unit price times 34 weeks for the total yearly price.

Did you want to use a single occurrence/application for the sake of calculating the Total bid services for 2017?

A: Unless specified in the bid document and addenda, whether an item is a single occurrence during the year or more than that is determined by the contractor. Example: The contractor will be expected to apply pre- and post-emergent herbicide and pull weeds as many times as it takes to keep the areas looking weed free. That said the District has no interest in paying for services that are not needed.

Q2. How many weeks is the contract in 2017?

A: 34

Q3. How often do you want cultivation?

A: Cultivation will be once per year. It can be raking/smoothing with a hard rake during spring clean-up.

Q4. At Kracklauer Park is the natural area along the Seavey drainage ditch. Is this area left natural? Does this area get edged?

A: The area is not included in the square footage the District estimated in the bid document. The District will continue to maintain the entirety of this area in-house.

Q5. The Bid Form in the Bid Document does not match the items as noted in Section III; Article I – Scope of Work

Q6. Question regarding Performance Bond requirement.

A: The District has determined a Performance Bond is not required. A Bid Bond is required to bid.

In the Contract Proposal specifications for Landscape Maintenance Services, Article 1 Scope of Work, 5.Pre-emergent Selective Herbicide Application section reads “Application shall be made immediately following spring cleanup to ensure effectiveness (~~see Maintenance Spreadsheets, Attachment C).~~”

Any other reference to “Maintenance Spreadsheets” and/or “attachment C” discovered in the entirety of the proposal document shall be considered incorrect and struck in the same manner.

III. February 21, 2017

In the Contract Proposal specifications for Landscape Maintenance Services, Article 1 Scope of Work, Cleanup Procedures section reads “Contractor shall be responsible for weekly pickup of litter, trash and other debris for the entire worksite.”-

In the Contract Proposal specifications for Landscape Maintenance Services, Article 1 Scope of Work, Cleanup Procedures section is amended to “Contractor shall be responsible for

biweekly (once every other week) pickup of litter, trash and other debris for the entire worksite.”-
