


# SLED HILL GUIDELINES

Keith Mione Community Park  
Hours 10 am - 8 pm



The sled hill will be open if there is more than three inches of snow and it has been inspected by our Parks Department. If open, lights will come on after dusk until 8 pm.

A staging area at the top of hill allows people to get prepared before starting down the slope. Rules are posted at the top of the hill.

The slope on the face of the hill is marked by snow fencing. The sled area falls between the fencing that runs parallel to Midlothian Road (on the west) and parallel to Dunbar Road (on the south).

All individuals wishing to sled should climb the hill on the far right side of the hill (west) facing the top. Individuals should sled down the hill, exit the bottom run-off and return up the hill making a counter-clockwise circle.

Fencing marks off the backside of the sled hill which should not be used for sledding. Individuals should not attempt to sled down the sides of the hill facing Midlothian Road (west face) or facing Dunbar Road (south face).

## REMEMBER:

- Area is unsupervised-use the sled hill at your own risk.
- Users assume full responsibility for determining if the conditions are safe for sledding.
- Parents/guardians are responsible for children—no supervision is provided.
- Use caution when sledding and be considerate of others.
- Sledding is permitted only in designated areas.
- Sledding is a hazardous activity and presents substantial risk.
- Ski, snowboard, and metal sled use is prohibited.
- The making of snow jumps on the sled hill is not allowed.

The sled hill is a popular, fun and inexpensive winter recreation activity. However, the inherent nature of the activity includes risk of injury. Please follow the guidelines above to enhance your sledding experience and keep everyone enjoying the hill safe.
