HIGH SCHOOL FISHING TOURNAMENT RETURNS TO DIAMOND LAKE

MUNDELEIN, IL —Mundelein Park District welcomes students from area high schools to Diamond Lake (<http://bit.ly/1Gylszl>) for a Bass Fishing Tournament hosted by Streamwood High School (http://www.edline.net/pages/S/Students/Clubs/Bass_Fishing_Club). The competition on **Saturday, September 24** puts anglers' fishing skills to the test. This is the fifth year that Diamond Lake is a stop in the Golden Sabre Fall Series which also includes Long Lake and Bangs Lake. "Our school record for biggest bass was caught by Zach Eldredge weighing 5 pounds, 14 ounces," Tournament organizer and Streamwood High School Bass Fishing Coach Marty Baker said of past tournaments on Diamond Lake, "Zach and Genarro Anabarro had a school record 5-fish bag weight of 18 pounds, 8 ounces."
